NOTICE

1. This is a follow-up notice in response to the article titled "Ex-condo security guard charged with extortion bid over TraceTogether app, impersonating police officer" dated on 21 February 2022. We, at Metropolis Security Systems Pte Ltd ("Metropolis"), unequivocally condemn any acts of corruption, extortion or impersonation of authority.

2. Metropolis was not aware of the details of the investigations against the security officer SSO Ganesan Gunasegaran at any point until the publication of the news yesterday. Whilst Metropolis had co-operated with the CPIB since the start of the investigation in Oct 2020, we are not privy to the details during the course of his employment with us as per instructed by CPIB.

3. When this news broke, we terminated the services of the said officer with immediate effect.

4. We would like to assure you all our security officers are thoroughly screened and notified with the Police Licensing Regulatory Department (PLRD) before any deployment to site. This case is purely a one-off incident.

5. May I, on behalf of Metropolis Security Systems Pte Ltd, sincerely apologize to the clients at the prestigious **Seahill** for the illicit conduct of the deployed security officer. We shall gather strength and experience from this episode and double our efforts so as to serve our clients better.
